As Eugene has shared, this summer/fall has been such a great time in the life of this ministry—Thank You, Lord! However, there are a couple of nuggets to share with you.

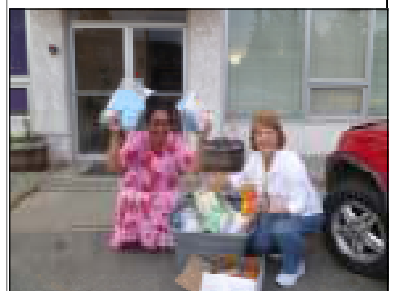
