## 2012 Projected Ministry Opportunities

Our focus for 2012 is building and strengthening relationships as we travel to Arizona, Alaska and into the world in Haiti, and Central America.

The potential for solid ministry in Arizona is quite good with the Navajo people. We have an invitation to return and “go deeper” with the folks there.

In Alaska there are good possibilities to travel to new Bush villages and teach young people in the schools about setting boundaries, goals and making a positive difference where they live. In Anchorage there are opportunities to hold VBS and adult meetings in a new church setting where we left children's material last summer, and did prayer walks with the pastors. There are possibilities for several teams including 1 project one in Alaska as well.

Travel to Haiti has a great potential as there are many village pastors who desire to learn more in order to better teach their congregations. Central America—making contacts and studying the needs of the people in that area for future work. In most of these places the need is great and the laborers are few where conditions are difficult. Traveling within these countries will be less expensive than others we have traveled. Looking forward with much anticipation for what the Lord has in store.

And then of course, helping at “home” where we are needed. As God opens door for us to assist the downtrodden, hopeless ones and/or lost where we live, we will be calling on you who may not can go on a “real” mission trip. “Real” is having to pay hundreds of dollars to travel a distance to minister. The Lord tells us it might just be the folks who live next door. So whether it is near or far, may we be about sharing the Lord with others. Praise the Lord for what God is doing in and through F.R.O.M. Ministries.
